SECOND SMASH YEAR FOR JERSEY BOYS!

Now in its 2nd year on stage at the Toronto Centre for the Arts, **JERSEY BOYS** is the story behind the music of Frankie Valli & The Four Seasons: Frankie Valli, Bob Gaudio, Tommy DeVito and Nick Massi. It tells the story of how four blue-collar boys from the wrong side of the tracks became one of the biggest American pop music sensations of all time. They wrote their own songs, invented their own sound and sold 175 million records worldwide - all before they were 30.

JERSEY BOYS stars **Michael Lomenda** as Nick Massi, **Jeff Madden** as Frankie Valli, **Daniel Robert Sullivan** as Tommy DeVito, and **Quinn VanAntwerp** as Bob Gaudio. True musical icons, The Four Seasons is one of very few American acts whose success was not derailed by the British invasion of the Beatles in 1964. With their 19 top ten hits, induction into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, and covers of their songs still hitting the pop charts, Frankie Valli & The Four Seasons is one of the most successful singing groups in rock and roll history. Their legacy continues with the cast recording of **JERSEY BOYS**, produced by Bob Gaudio, certified Gold by the Recording Industry Association of America.

Directed by two-time Tony Award® winner Des McAnuff, **JERSEY BOYS** is written by Academy Award winner Marshall Brickman and Rick Elice, with music by Bob Gaudio, lyrics by Bob Crewe and choreography by Sergio Trujillo.

JERSEY BOYS is the winner of the 2006 Best Musical Tony Award®, the 2006 Grammy Award® for Best Musical Show Album, and the 2009 Olivier Award for Best New Musical.

The Toronto production of **JERSEY BOYS** is the winner of two 2009 Dora Mavor Moore Awards; Outstanding Direction of a Musical for Des McAnuff and Outstanding Performance by a Male in a Musical for Jeff Madden, as well as the Audience Choice Award.

JERSEY BOYS Toronto is produced by Dancap Productions Inc., Dodger Theatricals, Joseph J. Grano, Tamara and Kevin Kinsella, Pelican Group in association with Latitude Link and Rick Steiner.
